The HDWG met for three days prior to IMBIZO III, and a smaller group met on 1 Feb to consider the suggestions and discussions from the IMBIZO III Human-Oceans-Humans Workshop, plus other outstanding issues. The notes below are a compilation of these discussions.

The greater part of the meeting was on further developing the ADApT framework. It was noted that the four components of ADApT (Description, Response, Appraisal and Typology) are necessarily interconnected and that this must be taken into consideration during their development. Also, as the Typology is the endpoint, the development of the Description, Response and Appraisal must be useful to the Typology; by the same argument, Typology development must consider what the input will be from the Description, Response and Appraisal. The full meeting agenda is in Appendix A, but in brief was:
